REQUIREMENTS: Essays should be typed and double-spaced, using a 10 or 12 point normal font such as New York, Times, Helvetica etc.

- Papers do not need a title page; however, they should list the first and last name of the student at the top, the period, instructor's name and the date.
- Students should attach any research articles that are used or cited. Evidence of plagiarism is grounds for failure x2.
